Garvey Schubert Barer (“GSB”) undertakes to provide its clients with summaries of FCC applications and actions, from information available from the Consolidated Database System (“CDBS”) of the FCC’s Media Bureau.

The geographic scope of reporting for each broadcast station client is based on two criteria. First, all items are included that report activity within a radius of 100 km from the client station’s licensed transmitter site. Second, all items are included that report activity on the same or adjacent channel to the client station.

The subject matter scope of reporting omits FCC activity reported by:

- International Bureau (Satellite)
- Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (Broadcast Auxiliary)
- Wireline Competition Bureau (Non-Broadcast)
- Cable Operations and Licensing System (COALS)

For all broadcast station clients, the subject matter scope of reporting omits, as to co-channel and adjacent channel broadcast station activity, applications and requests that do not involve a change in facilities.

For all radio station clients, the subject matter scope of reporting omits the following broadcast item types:

- TV station
- TV Interim Operation
- Educational TV station
- Experimental TV station
- Instructional TV Fixed Service
- UHF Translator station
- UHF Signal Booster
- UHF Low Power TV station
- TV Translator Relay station
- VHF Translator station
- Television Broadcast station
- VHF Low Power TV station
- License to cover CP

- License to cover CP for Interim Operation
- License for New Auxiliary Station
- Modification of License
- Renewal
- Direct Measurement of Operating Power

For all television station clients, the subject matter scope of reporting omits the following broadcast item types:

- Educational FM station
- FM Translator
- FM Booster
- FM station
- AM Interim Operation
- AM station
- License to cover CP
- License to cover CP for Interim Operation
- Modification of License
- Modification of LP Relay station Authority
- Renewal
- Renewal of SCA
- Subsidiary Communications Authority
- Direct Measurement of Operating Power

For assignment and transfer applications, only the lead station is reported because that is the only record in which the assignment or transfer is reported in CDBS. Additional stations in a multiple station transaction may be manually researched in the Commission’s Assignment of License / Transfer of Control (ALTC) database.
